ACADEMIC POSITION – CHAIR – PROGRAM IN CRITICAL CARE

The Departments of Medicine, Surgery and Anesthesia & Perioperative Medicine, Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry, at The University of Western Ontario, and its affiliated hospitals are seeking a physician for full-time clinical academic appointment to The University of Western Ontario. Applicants should be certified, or eligible for certification, by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, or equivalent. Candidates must have an MD or equivalent, and must be eligible for licensure in the province of Ontario. This appointment will be at rank of Associate, or Full Professor.

The University of Western Ontario is situated in picturesque London, Ontario, a city of approximately 340,000 along the banks of the Thames River. The City of London is a vibrant community with many family-friendly amenities and has one of the lowest cost of living rates in Ontario. The University of Western Ontario is a prominent academic institution that has made a commitment to balance its teaching and research mission and excel as a research intensive university. The Critical Care Program is centralized on two LHSC sites, University Hospital and Victoria Hospital. Seventy adult multi-disciplinary Level III critical care beds support all adult medical and surgical services, including invasive cardiology, cardiac surgery, thoracic, clinical neurosciences and multi-organ transplantation. Victoria Hospital is the regional trauma centre. The Critical Care faculty includes seventeen intensivists from medical, anesthetic and surgical backgrounds, a neurologist and palliative care physician. The program in Critical Care is a well established Royal College training program and facilitates an internationally renowned multidisciplinary research program in both the clinical and basic sciences.

Applicants for this position will also have a commitment to, and demonstrated aptitude for, teaching and will be expected to teach at the undergraduate and graduate levels and to supervise graduate trainees. Applicants will also have demonstrated strong leadership skills and established credibility in excellent patient care, education and/or research. Consideration of applicants will include an assessment of previous performance, qualifications, including qualifications which go beyond the requirements for the position, and experience. Rank, term of appointment and salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
